Fall Registration:

Volleyball: 1 3rd grade team
1 4th grade team
2 5th grade teams
2 6th grade teams
1 7th grade team
2 8th grade teams

Flag Football:
1 team (11 registrations) 2 coaches

Cross Country:
1 team (13 registrations)

Football:
1 8th grade team (combination of 5 parishes/25 registrations)(MDA, OLOL, St. Mary Mentor, St. John Vianney, and Sts. Robert/William)

- MDA equips the 8th grade team
- 7th grade (MDA students) has 3 registrations. However, there are a total of 38 athletes among the 5 parishes. Tom proposes MDA sponsor one of two teams and hope that another parish will step in and sponsor another (ie. MDA, SJV, and OLOL=19 athletes. St. Mary Mentor and Sts. Robt/Wm=19 athletes.)
- Financially, there should not be an issue registering/outfitting these teams.
- The next few years will show if there is enough interest in football to sustain the program.

Family Fall Sports Meeting: July 23, 2019

Help is needed in collecting checks for volunteering and uniform deposit. Steve, Lori, Mike have volunteered, others to stop in to help if needed. Steve will coordinate putting alphabetical lists together to make things run more smoothly.

Football parents will attend a separate meeting. Tom Madden will host.

Uniform distribution: Steve suggests getting sizes from parents and putting together each team's uniforms and giving to individual coaches for distribution. Football uniforms will be given on July 24, as they are needed for practices.

Flag football uniforms are still not decided upon by CYO. Adler's will be notified as soon as we are told the parameters of these uniforms.

First Aid kits are new and ready for distribution

Spirit Store (Dan Kilbane will get that together soon and 8th grade warm-ups will be chosen and purchased while parents can order sport specific spirit wear)

Miscellaneous:

Discussion was held to increase the number of times families must volunteer. All agreed to increase to 3 sessions/family or the check will be cashed. "No shows" to appointed times will also result in a cashed volunteer check. The amount remains the same at \$100 for volunteering and \$50 uniform deposit.

I.C. concessions: If someone steps up to take charge of this, it will be a bonus. If no one comes forward, the concessions at I.C. will close.

MDA concessions: Laurie Skillicorn has agreed to take over SignUp Genius for concessions/volunteers for volleyball and basketball. This will free up Ashley to do the shopping and other work in the stand.

Discussion was held about the possibility of athletes "playing up" due to high skill level, despite the fact that there might be enough players to form a team at upper grade level. It was decided that at this point, we will maintain teams per grade level and only allow an athlete to "play up" if there is a need to create a team and the numbers are necessary to have someone come up.
